5. DURABILITY: A Pattern maker as a template for each and every person she sews for. These templates can last for a very long time and are re-usable. Hence, the fit of your dresses are guaranteed. With freehand drafts can't be re-used.

This is just to keep it short. There are many more differences. With the above, one can probably conclude that pattern making is better but the conclusion should be that they are used for different purposes.

When making simple garments e.g boubou, iro and buba, kaftans

and the likes, it will just make sense to use Freehand provided you have the experience. But, if you are interested in having a Clothing line, or Couturing e.g red carpet worthy dresses, then Pattern Making is advised.
