Assist Pupils to identify and explain the difference between freehand cutting and drafting.		DEFINITION: Free hand cutting is the art of drafting designs directly on the fabric and cutting them out. It requires some level of experience gained over time mainly through trial and error. Pattern making on the other hand entails drafting templates from which patterns are then derived for desired design. 2.COST: Free hand cutting is cheap mainly because it is done directly on the fabric while certain tools and technicalities are involved in Pattern making. 3.TIME: Free hand cutting is fast. All the markings are done on the fabric and straight to cutting. Pattern Making is time consuming. Firstly, a template is made which is then manipulated to arrive at a pattern for the desired design. Possibly a mock design is done for fitting, alterations are done before finally going ahead to make the design. (as seen in Couturing). These templates can last for a very long time and are re-usable. Hence, the fit of your dresses are guaranteed. With freehand drafts can't be re-used.</p> <p>This is just to keep it short. With the above, one can probably conclude that pattern making is better but the conclusion should be that they are used for different purposes.</p> <p>When making simple garments e.g boubou, iro and buba, kaftans and the likes, it will just make sense to use Freehand provided you have the experience.
