What happened during the 1956 election;

It was held on Tuesday, November 6, 1956. President Dwight D. Eisenhower successfully ran for reelection against Adlai Stevenson II, the former Illinois governor whom he had defeated four years earlier. Presidential election results map.

How many seat did CPP won?

The CPP won all the 5 seats from the urban areas and 29 of the 33 seats from the rural areas.
