Bacteria in plaque produce acids after you eat or drink. These acids can destroy tooth enamel and cause cavities and gingivitis (gum disease)</p>  <p><b>How Plaques are formed on teeth;</b></p> <p>Plaque develops when foods containing carbohydrates (sugars and starches), such as <b>milk, soft drinks, raisins, cakes, or candy</b> are frequently left on the teeth. Bacteria that live in the mouth thrive on these foods, producing acids as a result.</p>	<p><b>Exercise;</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What is Plaque?</li> <li>Describe how Plaques is formed .</li> <li>Explain 3 ways of preventing plaque on teeth.</li> </ol>

Discuss the importance of taking care of teeth with the Pupils.</li> </ol> <p><b>Closure</b> Summarize the lesson.</p>		<p><b>Ways of taking care of the Human Teeth;</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Floss at least once per day.</li> <li>• Brush your teeth twice a day with a soft-bristled toothbrush.</li> <li>• Use fluoride toothpaste.</li> <li>• Replace your toothbrush every 3 to 4 months or sooner if needed.</li> <li>• Eat a healthy diet.</li> <li>• Avoid sweets and sweetened drinks.</li> <li>• Do not smoke.</li> </ul> 	<p><b>Exercise;</b> Explain 5 ways of taking care of the Human teeth.</p>
