Learners brainstorm to explain reasons why it is important to live a decent behaviour. <p>Ways of applying good manners in our daily lives;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ We must learn the habit of sharing things to others. ➤ We should be helpful, polite and humble to others in every possible way. ➤ We must use the words 'sorry', 'please', 'thank you', 'excuse me' and 'time wish' as and when required. <p>Reasons for living a decent behaviour;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Your being decent would actually earn you more respect from people. People will give you the respect you deserve if they know you respect them equally. Remember respect is reciprocal. 2. Your decency will make people take you seriously. This is utterly true in the sense that because you've in the first place taken yourself seriously by being morally upright in your behaviours and attitude, other people will do the same—it's just the law of reciprocity. 3. You stand to gain good reputation from your decent lifestyle. people will always speak good—and never ill—of you, because you’ve made yourself worthy of trust. People can as well use you as a good example so that others can do well to follow.
