			<p>Growth of Ghana.</p> <p><b>Closure:</b></p> <p>Pupils in small groups to discuss the effects of Population Growth on the world.</p>		<p><u><b>Effect of rapid population growth rate on national development:</b></u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Food situation:</b> - food production has not sufficiently increased to cope with population growth resulting in increase in the food gap and malnutrition among the fast growing population.</li> <li>2. <b>Health/medical services:</b> - the rapid increase in the population has overtaken improvements in health/medical services.</li> <li>3. <b>Education opportunities:</b> improvement of the capacity and quality of the educational system has been hampered by the rapid increase of the school age population.</li> <li>4. <b>Employment opportunities:</b> rapid population growth has made it difficult to increase employment opportunities.</li> <li>5. <b>Social services:</b> are impaired by overpopulation.</li> <li>6. <b>Distribution of income/wealth:</b> evidently the share of the individual families from the growth national production will be affected by the increase in population number.</li> </ol>
