Below are the major achievements of this political party in Ghana.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The CPP achieved independence for Ghana in 1957. 2. Secondly, it provided able and effective leadership in the struggle for self -rule by mobilizing and educating the masses on the shortcomings of the 1946 Burns Constitution and colonial rule as a whole. 3. The Convention People's Party administration also promoted the education of Ghanaian youth. It implemented a policy of fee-free primary education under its 1951 Accelerated Development Plan.
