1. Risk-taking

The primary reward of starting a successful business is profit, while the inherent risk is failure—and the personal and financial setbacks this might entail.

2. Vision

Every venture starts with a vision: the desired direction of the business and its overarching pursuits, even if they seem difficult to achieve. Stakeholders, like your employees and investors, look to you—and your vision—for guidance, motivation, and decisive leadership, especially when the going gets tough. While
