- Surah An-Nisa, verse 36: "Worship Allah and join none with Him in worship, and do good to parents, and to relatives, orphans, the needy, the neighbor who is near of kin, the neighbor who is a stranger, the companion by your side, the traveler, and those whom your right hands possess. Verily, Allah does not like those who are proud and boastful."
- **Surah Luqman, verse 14:** "And We have enjoined upon man to be good to his

	parents. His mother carried him in weakness upon weakness, and his weaning is two years. Be grateful to Me and to your parents. To Me is the final destination." These verses make it clear that obedience to parents is a fundamental Islamic principle. It is not only a matter of good manners, but also a religious obligation.
