

Using Poster and Pictures, assist Learners to identify examples of sketch map. A map is a figurative representation of selected characteristics of a place, usually depicted on a flat surface. They present evidence about the world in a simple, optical way. They inform us about the world by showing the sizes and shapes of countries, locations, and distances between places. A sketch map is a rough drawing of an area. It is drawn without scale. They are simple drawings of the landscape. They show things that are hidden in photographs or maps. These maps are drawn from the same viewpoint as a vertical aerial photograph. They usually show the main characteristics of an area and are not cluttered with unnecessary detail. Sketch maps are free hand maps drawn on blackboard to present geographic ideas and facts clearly and forcefully. Sketch mapping reduces unrelated detail and maximizes crucial geographic points.
