simply made up of the husband, wife and children. This is called the nuclear family. In Africa, the family includes relatives from both maternal and paternal sides. This is also known as extended family.

This relationship **binds** every member whose **origin** can be traced to the same ancestor. This has developed into such a complex group as clans among the Akans and kinship relatives in the other parts of Ghana and Africa.

Wherever the extended family is practiced, its benefits seem greater than its disadvantages. In Ghana at the small community level, it brings unity among people. They share everything among themselves been wealth or problems. The system even binds the **caters for** others who may be separated by social factors such as marriage.

However, it often makes some members become look up to others for help when they could not solve problems themselves. It also makes

some members become lazy. **In the long run** the only well-to-do person in the family is made to shoulder the responsibilities of more people than he can really **cope with.**
