Discuss with the Learners about how to organize target audience and space or venue of an exhibition. 2. Using a chart, discuss with the learners about how to preserve and exhibit art works. 3. Learners in small groups to discuss and report to the class about the similarities and differences of preserving and exhibiting art works. <p>PRESERVING ART WORKS;</p> <p>At times, you need to take your artwork off the walls and store it temporarily somewhere. Maybe during remodeling or moving. A few of our personal recommendations for storing art:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Paintings on canvas need to breathe, so avoid covering them with glass. 2. Similarly, covering artwork tightly with plastic isn't the best idea since humidity can get to it, and mold might start growing 	<p>Discuss with the Learners about the challenges of preserving and exhibiting art works.</p> <p>Exercise;</p> <p>Write 5 challenges of preserving and exhibiting art works.</p>

		<p>3. Cotton sheets are actually a good option: they stop direct sunlight, let the painting breathe, and don't scratch its surface.</p> <p>4. My favorite option is to use non-abrasive polyethylene foam pouches. They're lightweight, breathable, stop UV light, economical, and provide some protection from physical damages as well.</p>
