

Apostle James (son of Zebedee) The next Apostle we will look at is James, the son of Zebedee and the older brother of John. From the time, he was ordained an apostle, James occupied a prominent place among the apostles and, along with Peter and John, became the special confidant of Jesus. These three apostles alone were present at the raising of Jairus' daughter (Luke 8:51), at the Transfiguration, and at the Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. Apostle John (James' brother) John was the kind of man who could profit from the rebuke of Jesus. John's passionate disposition was held in check and under control, and he was allowed to vent only on occasions when it was permissible and even necessary.
