Purposes of Creation With the understanding that creation is inherently good and a gift from a loving God, we now turn to examine some of God's purposes for creation. God Creates with Purpose The architecture and composition of creation reveals the Creator's purposes. God created as an act of love and the purposes of creation support God's love.11 Creation is neither a random accident nor divine in itself. We understand creation as a gift that both reveals God and provides for humans. Creation Glorifies God Creation glorifies God in the goodness and splendour of its very being and order.12 Psalm 19:1–4 says, The heavens are telling the glory of God; and the firmament proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours forth speech, and night to night declares knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words; their voice is not heard; yet their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.
