Learners in small groups to discuss and Suggest ways for handling parent-child conflicts, including dialogue, effective communication.</li> </ol> <p><b>Parenting Style Definition &amp; Impact On Child Development</b></p> <hr/> <p>Parenting styles are categorized based on two dimensions of parenting behavior – demanding and responsive.</p> <p>Demandingness refers to how parents control their child's behavior or demand maturity.</p> <p>Responsiveness refers to how much parents are accepting and sensitive to their children's emotional and developmental needs</p>	Through questions and answers, conclude the lesson.  <b>Exercise;</b>  Explain 5 effects of Poor Parenting.
