Select a model reader to read fluently and with confidence reading texts loud to the class. Discuss how to write key points in a reading text. Individual Learners to read silently the reading text. Assist Learners to write key points in reading texts. Phonics. Phonics is the process of mapping the sounds in words to written letters. Phonemic awareness. Adjectives; Adjectives are words that describe the qualities or states of being of nouns: enormous, doglike, silly, yellow, fun, fast. They can also describe the quantity of nouns: many, few, millions, eleven Examples of Adjectives used in a sentences; They live in a beautiful house. Lisa is wearing a sleeveless shirt today. This soup is not edible. She wore a beautiful dress. He writes meaningless letters. This shop is much nicer. She wore a beautiful dress. Ben is an adorable baby. Linda's hair is gorgeous. 		Coherent Paragraph; A coherent paragraph has sentences that all logically follow each other; they are not isolated thoughts. Coherence can be achieved in several ways. First, using transitions helps connect ideas from one sentence to the next. For more on transitions,

Ways to Develop Coherent Paragraph	
Use phrases and not words. Computer technology.	
Choose appropriate paragraph length. Break to 2 or more paragraph.	
Topic Sentences. State the topic and main idea in a single perspective.	
Echo Words. Uses synonym words.	
Transition words.
